

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The project includes a new entrance and shop for the museum on Ditchling's village green in a converted listed barn. The principal new building on the site is constructed using KLH cross laminated timber, and clad with black zinc. Two new structures were inserted between the existing cart lodge and school buildings to connect them and provide a new gallery and storage area.

The project has been well received taking top honours at the 2014 Wood Awards, winning 3 RIBA Awards, 2 Sussex Heritage Awards, 1 WAN Award and was a finalist for the Art Fund Prize for Museum of the Year.
