

The hotel is located in Maranza in the Italien region of South Tyrol, in a unique landscape with panoramic view of the Dolomites.

To adapt to the scale of the surrounding buildings, the hotel was arranged in four offset buildings, thus visually reducing the volume. The inspiration comes from the traditional architecture of the region and the farm buildings made of wood. The natural construction material plays a major role in the Hotel Milla Montis – both inside and outside. The blackened facade contrasts with the light wood inside.

The interiors were kept light and functional. A material mix of loden textiles and ash wood provides a timeless alpine style.

Peter Pichler Architecture won an invited competition in 2019 to design a new hotel in northern Italy.
